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EXHIBIT A

1. CONTEST REQUIREMENTS:

- 1.1. The specified play or occurrence must occur by the home team in the specified inning during an official game which is played on a date covered by this contract for a contestant to win.
- 1.2. The specified occurrences must occur in the specified inning: (a) triple play shall occur when (and only when) all three outs are recorded by the specified team during a single continuous play; (b) grand slam shall occur when (and only when) a batter for the specified team hits a pitched ball over and beyond the outfield fence when there is a runner stationed at each of the three bases; (c) Three exclusive assists by the third baseman shall occur when (and only when) the third baseman turns all three exclusive assists during the half-inning. No other member of the team may record an assist during the inning (for example a 7-5-2 relay for an out at the plate credits both the left fielder and third baseman with an assist, and would be ineligible under the terms of this contract). An exclusive assist will occur only when the third baseman fields three ground balls and throws a runner out at any base. Recording a putout does not constitute an assist (whether by tagging the runner, tagging the base, or fielding the ball on the fly); (d) Two consecutive batters must hit home runs over and beyond the outfield fence to qualify for back-to-back home runs; specified team; (e) Hit for the cycle inning shall occur when (and only when) the specified team record an official single, double, triple and home run in the same inning. Any base runner reaching on an error will not apply; (f) An inside the park homerun must be ruled as an official four base hit. Any play in which an error occurs will not constitute a winning play regardless of whether the batter scores on the play; (g) A home run off of the foul pole shall occur when and only when a batter hits a pitched ball for a home run and the ball clearly comes in contact with either the right field or left field foul pole before going over the outfield fence without the aid of or coming in contact with any person or other object including a player or spectator. The hit must be ruled as an official home run by the umpiring crew; (h) A seven run seventh inning shall occur when the specified team score exactly seven runs in the seventh inning of a game covered by this contract; (i) Three exclusive assists by the second baseman shall occur when (and only when) the second baseman turns all three exclusive assists during the half-inning. No other member of the team may record an assist during the inning (for example a 9-4-2 relay for an out at the plate credits both the right fielder and second baseman with an assist, and would be ineligible under the terms of this contract). An exclusive assist will occur only when the second baseman fields three ground balls and throws a runner out at any base. Recording a putout does not constitute an assist (whether by tagging the runner, tagging the base, or fielding the ball on the fly).
- 1.3. The game covered by this contract must be an official game. If the game is cancelled for any reason prior to becoming an official game, all statistics are removed from the official score book. Therefore, there will be no claims acknowledged based on this game. All outcomes

must be recognized as an official play by the umpires at the game, the official scorer and applicable league office. Any change in the official scoring that would result in a winner under the terms and conditions of this contract must be completed prior to the completion of the game. Any changes to the scoring following the completion of the game that would result in a winner under the terms of this contract will not be acknowledged and no claim will be paid.

- 1.4. Any play which occurs as the result of a spectator who in any way interferes with an opposing player who is attempting to catch/field the ball (grabbing a player's arm, removing the ball from a player's glove, e.g.) Will not constitute a winning play for this contract, irrespective of the official scoring of the play.
- 1.5. Inside the park home runs, irrespective of the official scoring of the play, will not constitute a official winning home run for any grand slam, back-to-back, hit for the cycle or 3-run home run play covered by this contract. All home runs must clear the outfield fence to be considered eligible for a prize award.
- 1.6. Any collusion between players, coaches, team officials, members of media or any other party to produce a winning situation in regards to this contract in any manner is strictly prohibited. Any such action will immediately nullify this contract. If any collusion is discovered, all claims will be immediately forfeited.

2. CLAIM PROCEDURE:

- 2.1. All players must use standard equipment for any play or occurrence to be considered a winning play for the purposes of this contract. Bats filled with cork or any other illegal substance, or aluminum, graphite or porcelain bats, or loaded baseballs, and oversized gloves are strictly prohibited. Any play that occurs while any illegal or non-standard equipment is in use in any manner will not be acknowledged for the purposes of this contract.
- 2.2. The outfield fences may not be shortened in height or moved in for the games covered by this contract. The distance from home plate to the outfield fence in all areas (as well as the height of all fences) must measure the same as they

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have throughout the entire season. Likewise, the distances between each base (as well as pitcher's mound to home plate) must remain at regulation length.

3. CLAIM PROCEDURE:

- 3.1. In the event of a claim, a certified copy of the official scorer's report of the game and/or provide video of the occurrence in the specified inning and submit the names of two official witnesses who must certify that the event occurred.
